I loved the head and expression of this dog, good reach of neck and a good topline, very smart outline, sound and strong. Moved with drive

Class 5 Veteran Dog (3)

1 Worth's SH SC Shandwick Kristopher at Sarabande

Showing his age now but still has all the style that made him a show champion. Well balanced with a lovely Outline. Excellent on the move. Best Veteran

Very nice head and expression, correct topline and still very strong for his age scores in outline, but was beaten on movement today

Class 6 Maiden Dog (5) (4)

1 Glenbrows Magician

Class 7 Novice Dog (6) (5)

1 Sarabande Rio Grande

Nice head and expression with a good body shape, well presented but as with his brother he needs time. Would like a little more enthusiasm on the move

2 Tigerrock Stud Muffin

Completely different type to 1 but with a lot to like; Good overall outline however another one however that needs time

3 Tigerrock Bat Out Of Hell

Class 8 Graduate Dog (8)

1 Shandwick Promise

Lovely body shape with the correct topline and good angulation, scores in front and has a good reach of neck, plenty of bone. Best mover in the class

2 Menstonia Marksman

Good head and expression, neat shoulders and a good outline. Unlucky to meet 1 in such good form

3 Nyliram Billy No Mates

Class 9 Post Graduate Dog (4)

1 Slapestones Eros

Lovely overall shape, with a good head and expression, smaller made than 2 but with everything in the right place. Moved well at one with his handler.

2 Bonvis Fire n Ice

Heavier set than 1 but with good clean lines, good front and hocks, steady on the move but I would like more drive

3 Ypagneal Sacha Avec Tigerrock

Class 10 Mid Limit Dog (3)

1 Chanangel Sticky Wicket JW SH CM

Very Flashy young dog of good proportion. Loved his head and expression; very well balanced with a good overall body shape; Moved with plenty of drive

2 Slapestones Atlantic at Hawkroyd

Another with good clean lines and a good topline of a heavier type than 1 but with a lot to like. Gave his handler a hard time today

3 Ferndel Commander of Bethersden

Class 11 Limit Dog (11)

1 Taimeres Tomfoolery

Loved the head and expression of this dog. Good angulation front and back and a good reach of neck, loved his outline and when settled he moved well. CC and I was pleased that the Referee agreed and awarded him BIS

2 Slapestones Newman at Lyndil

Different type to 1 but still with good clean lines sound strong and well balance and moved with drive. Unlucky to meet 1

2 Glenbrows Rainman JW

Class 12 Open Dog (8)

Another classy dog. Good reach of neck and well laid shoulders, and a good topline, Neat compact, and well balanced. Moved with drive. Res CC and Res BIS
