Class 1 Veteran Dog (0)

Class 2 Minor Puppy Dog (1, 1a)

Class 3 Puppy Dog (1)

1. Tew's Pamicks Believe You Can – Nicely proportioned with a nice head, good depth of chest for a real youngster, good bone. Moved well if a little undisciplined, but I can forgive him that can't I.

Class 4 Junior Dog (4, 1a)

1. Chandler's Gentle-Men Adea with Chanangel (Imp Pol) – Another dog of good proportion with a nice masculine head, nice tight feet. Really well turned out. Showed well for a youngster, moved best in class.
2. Jackson's Tigerrock Stud Muffin at Hawkroyd – Quite good in all departments, developing quite a nice head, really lost the class on movement and self-confidence.

Class 5 Yearling Dog (2)

1. Jackson's Tigerrock Stud Muffin at Hawkroyd
2. Gibson's Cadehill Poltross Burn - Very raw immature dog, well proportioned if a little on the large side. Head quite masculine and nice tight feet.

Class 7 Graduate Dog (3)

1. Morgan's Amiro Wind from the Hills - Masculine head, well boned, tight feet, good forequarters, nice topline. Moved well to win the class.
2. Backhouse & Scougall's Ferndel News Flash from Shannas - Nicely proportioned, not quite so nice a head as 1st place but equally good in most departments, but didn't move quite so well.
3. Jackson's Tigerrock Stud Muffin

Class 8 Post Graduate Dog (4)

1. Dyer's Rough Diamond Among Tylwith - Raw & immature, lean but very fit. Nice head, good fore and hind quarters, nice topline. Moved far and away best in class, striding out well in front and driving really well at rear.
2. Lemin's Bonvis Fire N Ice - Not quite so nice a head as 1st place but well proportioned, nice feet, good bone and moved well.

Class 9 Limit Dog (6)

1. Cocking & Barnaby's Bushwacker Captain Courageous at Ruskinite ShCM - A well proportioned young dog with a nice masculine head with kind expression. Nice tight feet, good spring of rib. Good fore and hind quarters. Moved well, striding out in front and driving at the rear. BD & RBIS
2. Graham's Furness Way from Minebea to Nyliram - Another well proportioned dog with a nice head and expression, tight feet, good bone. In good condition. Just lost out on movement today. RBD
3. Butler & Holley's Shandwick Promise

Class 10 Open Dog (2)

1. Tew's Pamicks Dazzling Boy - A well boned masculine dog with nice head & expression. Deep chest, well sprung ribs, good fore and hind quarters. Moved well.
2. Clark's Jeavart Different Strokes by Tigerrock JW ShCM – smaller dog than 1st place. Pleasing head, good reach of neck, good hindquarters, just lost out on movement & forequarters.

1. Clark's Tigerrock Eye of the Tiger JW ShCM – Nicely proportioned, lovely feminine head, good feet, bone and bend of stifle. Moved well. BV

Class 14 Minor Puppy Bitch (1)

1. Chandler's Chanangel Kathrine Jenkins - A beautiful puppy with a nice head with a good dark eye colour. Good bone, nicely sprung ribs, moved quite well. A little erratic on the move, but still moved well and that can be forgiven in a raw youngster.

Class 15 Puppy Bitch (2)

1. Backhouse's Glenbrows Truth About Aindrea – Well proportioned with nice feminine head, good reach of neck. Good forequarters, spring of rib, bend of

stifle, nice tight feet. Won the class on marginally better movement than 2nd place. BPB & BPIS

2. LeMaitre's Pamicks Alice Springs to Vannelmead – Another nice bitch with a nice head, good bone, spring of rib and good forequarters. Didn't move quite so well as 1st place today.

Class 16 Junior Bitch (3)

1. Tully's Bushwacker Gregorys Girl at Highclare – A really lovely youngster with a nice head, good reach of neck, spring of rib, bend of stifle,, nice tight feet, well boned. Moved by far and away best in class,
2. Clarke & Casey's Tigerrock Wild is the Wind – Another lovely youngster with a nice head, good spring of rib, bend of stifle, nice feet but lost out on movement.
3. Morgan & Schofield's Ferndel Silhouette at Cwsscwn

Class 19 Graduate Bitch (2)

1. Frost's Cochnaid's Cartier Diamond - A bitch of correct size, well proportioned with a nice head, good forequarters, nice topline and well sprung ribs. Moved really well to win the class.
2. Morgan's Amiro Wind of Change - Another bitch who was well proportioned and of correct sizxe. Same remarks as 1st place apply, but lost out on movement.

Class 20 Post Graduate Bitch (2, 1a)

1. Enior's Pennylock Tamara avec Jonsen - A bitch of nice size and good proportion, good fore and hind quarters. Well psrung ribs and nice topline. Moved well and handled well by a youngster.

Class 21 Limit Bitch (5)

1. Tew's Pamicks Tilly Trotting – A bitch with a lovely sweet feminine head with soft kind expression. Good dark eye, nice ear set, good reach of neck, good well laid back shoulders, nice forequarters, nice topline, good spring of rib. Sound all through. Moved really well, striding out in front, driving well behind. Despite growing on to be a bit large for my preference, taking the whole picture into c9nsideration, she just had to be BB & BIS
2. Leary's Menstonia Minty of Haslemount – A smaller bitch than 1st place, more the size I prefer. Nice head with a nice soft expression, well boned.

Nicely balanced throughout. Moved soundly but not quite so good as 1st place in front action.

Class 22 Open Bitch (3)

1. Morgan & Schofield's Sh Ch Ferndel Butterkist Cwsscwn JW – Well proportioned, turned out in good firm condition, sound throughout. Nice head and expression , well boned, good fore and hind quarters. Moved well. RBB
2. Graham's Sh Ch Nyliram Sparkling Pearl JW – Well balanced throughout. Lovely head with nice expression, deep chest. Moved well but not quite as good as 1st place
3. Sutherland's Sh Ch Julita Rezanella of Jacranella
